

# PRIVACY POLICY & COOKIE LAW

In this section we describe the modalities for site management regarding handling of personal data collected from the user.

Data will be collected and handled according to Recommendation number 2/2001, adopted on May 17, 2001 by the European Authorities for the protection of personal data, in order to identify common minimum requirements for on-line collection of personal data within the European Union. Also, this Recommendation supplies added information on the subject, according to [Article 13 of Law Decree dated June 30, 2003, number 196](#) – Codex, in the matter of personal data protection.

This information refers only to the sites [www.salviharps.com](http://www.salviharps.com)

therefore it does not apply to other websites that might have been visited by the user through a link.

The owner of the personal data of individuals identified or identifiable treated following the consultation of our site is NSM SPA at the head office in Piasco (CN – Italy), via Rossana, 7, 12026.

## DATA HANDLING LOCATION

The services connected to the web services of this site are carried out at the aforementioned site (except for the hosting aspects provided by the Service Provider Aruba Spa) and are handled only by technical personnel. No data deriving from the service is communicated or disseminated outside the company. Personal information provided by users submitting requests for information is used solely for the purpose of performing the requested service or service and is communicated to third parties in the sole case where this is necessary for that purpose.

## TYPES OF HANDLED DATA

### Navigation data / cookies

Our company applies the Measure of Authority for the Protection of Personal Data "Identifying the Simplified Modes for Information and Acquisition of Consent for the Use of Cookies" of May 8, 2014 - [Doc. web n. 3118884] (Published in Official Journal No 126 of 3 June 2014).

Cookies are tiny text files that can be placed on your computer or mobile device that uniquely (but anonymously) identify your browser or device. They are unable to search your computer in any way, cannot introduce viruses to your computer and contain no personal identifying information about you.

Cookies are used by sites or services when they want to know if your computer or device has visited that site or service before. These cookies on your computer or device can then be used to help remember your preferences (such as language), help you navigate between pages efficiently, and generally improve your browsing experience. While browsing a site, the user may also receive site or web server cookies other than what he is visiting (i.e. third-party cookies) on his / her computer or mobile device. Some operations could not be done without the use of cookies, which in some cases are therefore technically necessary for the same functionality of the site.

There are several types of cookies that can be synthesized with the following table:

- **Strictly Necessary Cookies.** These cookies are essential, as they enable you to move around the website and use its features.
- **Performance Cookies.** These cookies allow to understand how the site is used by users. These cookies do not collect personal data. The information is treated in aggregate and anonymous form.
- **Functionality Cookies.** These cookies are used to activate specific site features and a set of selected criteria (for example, language, products selected for purchase) in order to improve the service rendered.
- **Third Party Cookies.** Cookies of sites or web servers other than those hosting this site, used for purposes of their own third parties.
- **Targeting Cookies,** even third-party cookie, designed to create user-related profiles that are used to send advertisements in line with the preferences displayed by the user in his network browsing.

## ACTIONS ON COOKIES

In any case, the user can use the functionality of each browser to authorize, block, or delete (in whole or in part) cookies; in the event that all or some of the cookies are disabled, the site may be unenforceable or some services or certain site features may not be available or may not work properly and / or the user may be forced to edit or enter manually some information or preferences whenever he visits the site. ## **DATA SUPPLIED VOLUNTARILY BY USER**

## **OPTIONALITY OF DATA CONFERRING**

Aside from what is specified for the navigation data, the user is free to provide the personal data contained in any information request forms.

Failure to do so may result in the impossibility of obtaining what is required.

## **RIGHTS TO THE PARTIES INVOLVED**

In order to exercise the rights established by [article 7 of Law Decree 196/2003](#) and articles 15-22 of GDPR, subjects to whom personal data are referenced have the right at any time to obtain confirmation of the existence or not of the same data and to know its content and source, to verify its accuracy or to request its integration or updating, or rectification.

According to the same articles, users have the right to request the cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or the blocking of the data processed in violation of the law, as well as to oppose in any case, for legitimate reasons, their treatment.
